Over 13,300 people diagnosed in WA each year



Up to 7,000 cancer cases estimated to have gone undiagnosed, or were diagnosed at a later stage in Australia in 2020 due to COVID-19

How we help



\$1.2 million worth of health care in complementary therapies delivered free in 2020



Delivered 16,000 therapies to cancer patients and their carers in 2020 in spite of the lockdown, travel restrictions and health uncertainties of COVID-19



Almost 7,000 episodes of treatment were provided to regional cancer patients in 2019



Cover 2,646,000 square kms

Our patients come from across the State from Kununurra to Esperance



26 peer-reviewed articles published contributing to the study of complementary therapies



The need for our services rose by 16% in 2020, but COVID-19 meant Solaris could only operate at reduced capacity



14% reduction in side effects such as pain, fatigue and nausea



Psychological scores improve roughly 8% per session – reducing stress, anxiety and depression and resulting in increased empowerment
